


During lockdown our Careers and Personal Development programme continued with a number of activities based on our online platform Unifrog. This is a complete destination online platform, a one-stop shop for students across Key Stages 3, 4, 5 regardless of their interests or academic ability.

As part of personal development and careers learning during lockdown, students in year's 7 to 10 and year 12 have completed a variety of tasks to help familiarise themselves with the platform and start to get to know what their own profile looks like. Currently 888 students have signed up to the platform, taking part in the personality quiz and starting to record their competencies

Year 12 have started to create a CV and draft a personal statement in preparation for applying for their next steps. Whilst our incoming Year 7 have also received logins for the platform and have already started to take their own personality quiz and look at competencies. This gives our students a starting point to start thinking about their aspirations and what their journey with us might look like.


